DISCOUNTS

Discounts for the following reasons may be offered for pupils who attend full-time education in RECEPTION to YEAR 8; however, this will be at the sole discretion of the Headmistress.

- **Siblings**

A 7.5% discount for a second child and 12.5% for subsequent children attending Yarrells at the same time; this discount would apply to tuition fees only.

- **Armed Forces Personnel**

A 10% discount to Armed Forces personnel for the first child only attending Yarrells; this discount would apply to tuition fees only.

Conditions and General Information

- A **non-returnable registration fee** of £50 per child is payable to register a place for a child to join Yarrells School (this applies from PIPS to Yr 8 but not Music Box).
- **The first term's fees** for new pupils remain payable in full by the first day of the term, once the place offered has been accepted.
- A **FULL TERM'S WRITTEN NOTICE IN ADVANCE** (due on or before the first day of the previous term) must be given in the case of withdrawal, or a full term's fees will be charged.
- Fees are strictly payable either in advance or by the **first day of the school term** (known as The Due Date).
- If full payment is made by '**The Due Date**' then all eligible pupil invoices may have **£100** deducted from the fees invoice total, known as the **Prompt Payment Deduction**. Eligibility: Nursery Option 1 and Option 2, Pre-Preparatory and Preparatory pupils.
- The school will charge **interest at 2.5%** per month in respect of any invoice not fully paid by 'The Due Date', calculated in advance, and the £100 'Prompt Payment Deduction' will not apply. Parents may like to consider the **School Fee Plan Monthly Scheme** if they wish to pay in monthly instalments. Please note that the £100 a term 'Prompt Payment Deduction' will not apply if using this scheme. Yarrells will exclude pupils from attending school should any fees remain outstanding at the Half-Term period.
- No remission of fees from the school is possible through illness, accident or quarantine. However, a **School Fees Refund Scheme** (for refund of fees in case of illness) is available for children from Reception upwards – please see below.
- Pupils are accepted into the Pre-prep on the understanding that they will continue into the main school unless the school feels that this is not in the best interests of the child.
- A **deposit of £200** per pupil (Reception to Year 8) or **£75** (Nursery) will be due on acceptance of a place in school and refunded at the end of the final term (less any extras incurred). This deposit is non-refundable in the event of the pupil not taking up the accepted place. When the pupil moves from Nursery to the main school, the balance of **£125** will be due with the entry term invoice.
- The school operates three schemes:
 1. **School Fee Plan Monthly Scheme.** This allows parents to spread the cost of school fees via a monthly direct debit payment arrangement, details of which are available from the School Financial Manager.
 2. **Pupils' Personal Accident Insurance Scheme.** This excellent cover is included in the initial account for every pupil, details of which are available from the School Financial Manager.
 3. **School Fees Refund Scheme.** This scheme for refunding fees where a pupil is absent due to sickness or accident is included in the initial account (Reception upwards). However, should you not wish to take advantage of this scheme, please inform the School Financial Manager and delete this charge from the invoice.
